Dear Tom,

The following is a written description of the state licensing requirements we discussed on Friday, February 26th, 2010 at 26 Bull Run.

The license concerned will be issued for "Community residential services", defined by OASAS as "chemical dependence residential services providing supervised services to persons making the transition to abstinent living. Persons appropriate for this service require the support of a drug and alcohol-free environment while receiving either outpatient services or educational and/or vocational services. These transitional residential services are for individuals who are completing or have completed a course of treatment, but who are not yet ready for independent living due to outstanding clinical issues or unmet needs for personal, social or vocational skills development. These services are appropriate for individuals who require ongoing clinical support."

In conjunction with the license, residents will receive such non-clinical services as seminars on recovery, education on life issues, education on 12 step programs, education on addition, physical fitness, nutritional counseling, on and off site 12 step meetings and recreational activities.
